A flood advisory for the Beach Grove and Boundary Bay neighbourhoods of Tsawwassen remains in effect.

Emergency operations staff and Delta crews are on scene monitoring tide levels, a high tide is expected at 7:30 am, which may pose a risk of flooding to these areas.

The winds have not reached the maximum forecasted speeds.

The Corporation of Delta has activated its Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) at Delta Municipal Hall and will be monitoring conditions in the area. Mayor Lois E. Jackson and Chief Administrative Officer, George V. Harvie, are in attendance.
