A flood advisory for the Beach Grove and Boundary Bay neighbourhoods of Tsawwassen remains in effect. Strong winds combined with heavy rainfall and a high tide expected at 7:30 am, continue to pose a risk of flooding to these areas.

The Corporation of Delta has activated its Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) at Delta Municipal Hall and will be monitoring conditions in the area. Mayor Lois E. Jackson and Chief Administrative Officer, George V. Harvie, are in attendance.

Emergency operations staff and Delta crews are on scene for this weather event. Staff has been present at Delta's EOC since 5:30 am monitoring the situation.
