

The name of photographer or any other identification must not be visible. Only unaltered photographs will be considered for the contest.

**Judging:**

Three winners from each category will be selected from among all eligible entries received. One grand prize winner will be chosen out of all eligible entries received (does not include Delta staff entries). The judging will be conducted by Corporation of Delta Mayor and/or Council. By entering this contest, participants agree to abide by the contest rules and recognize that the decision of the judging committee is final. The quality of the photograph, relevance to the theme of the contest, and creativity/originality will all be examined in conjunction with artistic merit.
